No Worries

Sidney was only 4 years old which is a pretty scary time of life. Her family moved to a different house in a new town and she had problems adjusting. She thought she heard noises when the rest of her family was asleep. She feared there might be monsters in this new house, but she didn't know who to ask to help her search for them. However her mom took Sidney to a community forum to aid children in moving adjustment.

There she met police officer David Bonday. Sidney explained that she was afraid the monsters would come out at night and hurt her family. Although David had no experience in monster hunts, he agreed to search with her. He came to her house and together they checked all the usual locations for monsters: closets, under the beds, under the couch, and cabinets. He even loaned her his flashlight so she could look for herself, and he pointed out that even though she looked under the couch, they probably should check under the cushions, too. Fortunately they didn't find any monsters, but what they did find something else, **friendship!** Sidney now calls Officer Bonday her "best friend," and he invites her to sit in his police cruiser. What do you think Sidney wants to be when she grows up? That is correct, she wants to be a police officer. Officer Bonday's caring friendship has earned her fierce loyalty and a desire to imitate him.

Doesn't that sound a bit like how followers of Jesus can influence others so they want to also be friends of Jesus? Consider if you would 1 Peter 5: 6-7 "**Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you**" Sometimes our anxieties in life are frightening. Maybe it is a diagnosis that is negative, or a friend is suffering some terrible trauma. Yet God did not create us to be alone with anxiety. He wants us to live joyously with Him and trust Him to provide everything we need. Maybe we think that God can't understand what we have to deal with in life, but that's not true. God knows through the experiences of Jesus precisely how we feel. He knows the fears of being human because God the Son was one of us. God wants us to know that He has our best interests at heart.

That is why Jesus came among us and lived like we do. Then He died. It was a slow painful way to die. However then comes the wonder. He arose from the dead to live again. In so doing He shows us that death is not the loss of everything. He knows our anxieties, and He cares for us. He wants us to trust Him through all our difficulties. He wants to walk with us every day. Will we give Him permission to do this and become our best friend?
