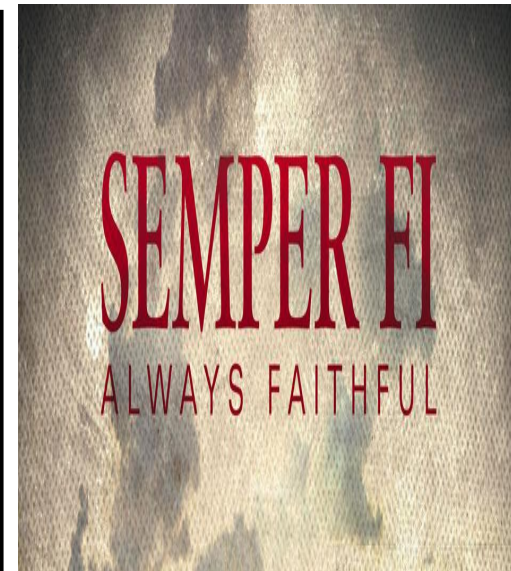

Who Is My Neighbor?

In 2004 I had the privilege of going to the country of Ghana in West Africa and was able to see how people in another society respond to the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and also how they react to the Biblical account of Jesus of Nazareth. It was probably one of the best experiences in my life. I learned to take a second look at how the Master communicated with people, and how He pointed them to what was really important. When I was having a conversation over lunch one day with a couple my brothers in the Lord, and one of them asked me about my time in Ghana and what I learned. To this day I still recall what I told him. "I believe I saw first century Christianity in the twenty first century." The reason I said that is because the followers of Christ in Ghana had learned the lesson of loving your neighbor like you love yourself! Wasn't that what the Master was talking about in Luke 10:27-29?

"He answered: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind'; and, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" "You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live." But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?" This is where the Master tells the story of what we often refer to as the parable of the good Samaritan. The people of that time did not really get to know one another. In varying degrees we also lose touch with those who live around us. The question asked by the expert in the Law of Moses "Who is my neighbor" takes on a whole new meaning. We need to learn how to relate to others and share the only message that can really change people for the better.

We as Christians need to be serving and interacting with the community where we live. We can't sit back and wait for our neighbors to come find us. We have to get out and meet them. Some believers are good at naturally connecting with others around them, while others need help doing so. What can we do to reach the lost in our communities?

Here are a few suggestions.

1. Pray for your neighborhood every day.
2. Serve your community.
3. Let the community see your good deeds and praise God.
