I Took Your Place!

One day, a man went to visit a church assembly. He got there early, parked his car, and got out. Another car pulled up next to him and said, "I always part there! **You took my place!**" The visitor went inside for Bible study class, found an empty seat and sat down. A young lady from the church approached him and stated, "That's my seat! **You took my place!**" The visitor was somewhat distressed by this rude welcome, but said nothing. After Bible class the visitor went into the auditorium and sat down. Another member walked up to him and said, "That's where I always sit! **You took my place!**" The visitor was troubled even more, but he said nothing. Later as the congregation was praying for Christ to dwell among them, the visitor stood up, and his appearance began to change. Horrible scars became visible on his hands and on his sandaled feet. Someone from the congregation noticed him and called out, "What happened to you?" The visitor replied, as his hat became a crown of thorns, and a tear fell from his eye, "**I took your place!**"

Consider the words of Psalms 22:6-18, "**But I am a worm and not a man, scorned by men and despised by the people. All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: "He trusts in the LORD; let the LORD rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him." Yet you brought me out of the womb; you made me trust in you even at my mother's breast. From birth I was cast upon you; from my mother's womb you have been my God. Do not be far from me, for trouble is near and there is no one to help. Many bulls surround me; strong bulls of Bashan encircle me. Roaring lions tearing their prey open their mouths wide against me. I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint. My heart has turned to wax; it has melted away within me. My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; you lay me in the dust of death. Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me, they have pierced my hands and my feet. I can count all my bones; people stare and gloat over me. They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing."**

Sometimes, we can be more selfish in our actions than we realize. We tend to get wrapped up in our own personal routines and we act foolishly and selfishly toward others without realizing what we doing and saying. The story of Jesus and the Cross is the single most selfish act ever demonstrated toward humanity as Jesus chose death in our place.

Let us always be reminded of His selfless act and then seek to exemplify that same level of selflessness in our own lives. Instead of accusing others of "**taking our place**" let us always be mindful of opportunities to **provide** others with a place here at East Broad Street through the power of the blood of Christ!
